However, if we receive a significant number of Abstracts in other languages (e.g. French or Spanish), interpretation on the opening plenary session may be arranged as well as a workshop room and a relevant language moderator for these presenters.

Abstracts should not exceed 5.000 characters including spaces (circa 3.000 characters without spaces).

Deadline: 31 December 2015.

Abstracts are going to be peer reviewed by the members of the Scientific Committee.

Notification about acceptance: 01 February 2016.

Presentations are supposed to be 15 minutes long, leaving 5 minutes for discussions.

Students, PhD students are welcome for presenting posters or 5-10 minute presentations. The best students' presentations will be awarded by the exemption of registration fee.

We are planning opportunities to publish papers in special editions of journals as well as Conference Proceedings with an ISBN number. All delegates who submit their papers by 30 April 2016, will also have the chance to have their papers included on a USB which will be given to all delegates on registration.
